*The Department of Agricultural Sciences of the University of Naples "Federico II" is located in Portici, hosted in the **Royal Palace** built in 1738 by the Charles of Bourbon, King of Naples and Sicily. Since the unification of Italy the Palace has hosted the High Royal School of Agriculture, which became part of the University of Naples in 1935. It has been a key reference for the scientific, economic and cultural development of the Southern Italy, thus contributing to the transformation of the rural areas into one of the most productive agricultural territories in the Mediterranean. Portici is near to Naples (11 km), Herculaneum (1 km), Vesuvius (5 km), Pompei (15 km) and Sorrento (36 km), which can be easily reached by railway connections.*

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
